Communications Regulation in Europe

Course Description

This two-day course, taught by Neil Brown, Associate Lecturer of the United Kingdom Telecommunications Academy (UKTA), provides exposure to the regulatory environment for communications in Europe.

The course offers a broad overview of the European regulatory model, licensing and authorization, the role of the regulator, and the impact of liberalization in Europe. Participants will explore technology neutrality and convergence, European legislation for communications and the ?over the top? communications services, with an emphasis on understanding the policy underpinnings of communications regulation.

Learning Objectives

A broad overview of the policy underpinnings and an understanding of the challenges and impact of regulating a fast moving, highly converged, connected society. Participants will:

- ? Develop an understanding of the goals and concerns of European policymakers, and the context in which policy is formulated
- ? Gain an understanding of core areas of law and policy, and how they are applied
- ? Apply European communications regulation and principles in a practical context, through structured thematic exercises
